Search for Awards

To search for an award, do the following:

1. Access the **Award Search** page:
 - From the URL (<http://www.nsf.gov/awardsearch/index.jsp>)
 - From the FastLane Homepage (<https://www.fastlane.nsf.gov/fastlane.jsp>):
 - a. Click the **Award Search and Funding Trends** Quick Link on the left-hand side of the page.
 - b. Click **Search Awards** on the **Award Search and Funding Trends** page.
 - c. Click **Award Search** on the **Award Search** page.
2. Determine which search option is best on the basis of the award information that you have.
3. Click the corresponding search tab.
4. Complete at least one of the search criterion fields.
5. Click the **search** button to search. Or, click the **reset** button to clear the fields and start again. Awards matching your search criteria are displayed in a table with the following information:
 - Award Number
 - Title
 - NSF Organization
 - Program(s)
 - Start Date
 - Principal Investigator
 - State
 - Organization
 - Awarded Amount to Date

Improve Search Results

You can improve your search results by keeping the following in mind:

- Enter as many search criteria that you can to generate more specific results.
- Enter few search criteria to potentially increase the results.
- Use wild card searches when you know little about the specific award. For example, enter part of the program name in the results list (e.g., "bio" instead of "biography") with the trailing wild card symbol--an asterisk (*)--as in "bio*". Wild card symbols represent one or more characters. That is, using "bio*" will return results that match any words that begin with "bio" and one or more characters thereafter (e.g., "biography", "biology", "biologist", "biophysics", etc).
- Contact the National Science Foundation (NSF) when all else fails. When contacting NSF, provide as much information about your search as possible and include your email address or phone number.

Export Award Searches

To export (save) your award search results, do the following:

1. Scroll to the bottom of your search results page.




Figure 1 Download Options.

2. Right-click on the icon (Figure 1) for the export format you want to download. You can export search results in Microsoft® Excel®, XML, or CSV formats.




Figure 2 Saving File in Internet Explorer.

3. Click **Save Target As** (Internet Explorer for Microsoft Windows) (Figure 2)
